Exports are responsible for 20% of U.S. farm income




Supports more than 1 million American jobs, both on and off the farm



▶ In 2017, \$375 billion trade deficit with China.



- ▶ U.S. imported approximately \$506 billion from China.
- ▶ U.S. exported over \$130 billion to China
- ► The Trump administration proposed and implemented a series of tariffs on products from China, which led to retaliatory actions by the Chinese government.

### U.S. – CHINA TRADE CHALLENGES



► March 23, 2018, U.S. impose 25% tariffs on steel and 10% tariffs on aluminum.

- ► April 2, 2018, China suspended tariff reduction obligations on U.S. products.
  - ► Fruit and nut products, wine, ginseng, pork, and ethanol.
  - ► Impact on Georgia Ag: Pecan is included with 15% increase in tariff rate.

# U.S.-CHINA TRADE DISPUTES TIMELINE



- ▶ June 15, 2018, U.S. announced 25% tariff on goods imported from China valued at about \$50 billion.
  - ▶ \$34 billion of goods are subject to tariffs on July 6, 2018.
- ▶ June 16, 2018, China announced a list of U.S. products subject to additional 25 percent tariff.
  - ▶ \$34 billion will be subject to additional tariffs on July 6, 2018.
  - Impact on Georgia AG: Corn, Cotton, Sorghum, Soybean, wheat, and Poultry

### U.S.-CHINA TRADE DISPUTES TIMELINE



- ► August 8, 2018, China announced an updated list of \$16 billion in U.S. products that will be subject to an additional 25 percent tariff beginning on August 23, 2018.
  - Waste cotton yarn and other cotton waste are on the list


